"Godspell literally tells the story of Jesus from beginning to end - and it does so in a way that engages people of all ages in the acting, the singing and the telling of the story of God's love."

The Easter Community Theater production of Godspell will be this Spring. "We are looking forward to an incredible and down-to-earth production, so I'm excited for auditions to get underway," explains Jason Hansen. "There is so much talent in this community, and Eagan has a huge reputation for great art. I'm glad we can offer people a new theater program in which to become involved."
