Welcome to Adventures on Promise Island! Excitement and fun await as kids learn about promises that God made to people in the Bible. The kids will also see how those promises are for them too!

Each day at **Seaside Celebration** kids will participate in large-group music, skits, and fun as they are introduced to the life-changing promises God made. Then, after kids experience the other activities of the day, they'll gather back at Seaside Celebration to review, to be encouraged, and to be motivated to live their lives confident that God will keep those promises!

At **Lifeguard Lagoon** kids will actively participate in telling Bible stories, then gather in small groups to discuss ways they can apply the stories to their lives. NATIONAL TRIPS:

The Ozarks (Booneville, AR), June 30—July 7

Grades 9-12, *may still have spots open; Cost: \$500

Students will have the opportunity to partner with local ministries- through YouthWorks. They will serve directly through home improvement projects and by serving local children and elderly residents.

Washington DC, July 7—14

Grades 9-12, *may still have spots open; Cost: \$550

Students will serve directly through local service agencies and YouthWorks; possibilities may include soup kitchens, homeless shelters, children's organizations, or senior living associations.

Milwaukee, WI, July 29—August 3

Grades 7-12, *may still have spots open; Cost: \$450

Students will serve directly through local service agencies and YouthWorks; possibilities may include soup kitchens, homeless shelters, children's organizations, or senior living associations.

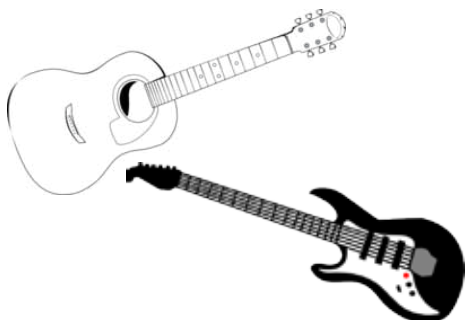
