A large commons space with an expansive view of the lake, that links the Worship space with the existing building will be a hub of activity at Easter. This Commons will be designed to welcome and gather in community.

Children, youth, and adults will have ample space throughout the building to gather, learn, and grow together.

The staff will come together in one office space, facilitating efficient and effective ministry as they work closely together.

These new and refreshed spaces will serve the entire community and will allow our outreach partners, including Loaves and Fishes, Homework Help, TreeHouse, and Easter Preschool to continue their powerful work.
